- Fundraising to support projects that promote knowledge and understanding of plant research among the public in a target group-oriented manner

This position is suitable for a person who has both first-hand research experience as well as experience in science communication and who is passionate about developing innovative approaches for communicating plant science to diverse target audiences. Excellent communication skills in English and proficiency in computer applications (MS office, internet, databases, content management systems) are essential as are knowledge of the German research landscape and proficiency in the German language. The ideal candidate works proactively, is solution-oriented and flexible in their thinking, as well as adept at efficiently prioritizing their tasks. They also enjoy working collaboratively with colleagues at all levels, both in and outside the Institute.
